

## Traditional Maasai Herding




### **Conservationists Demonize Masaai**

### SUCCESSFUL APPLICATIONS OF DDT


- Stopped typhus epidemics;

- Significantly reduced malaria outbreaks in Africa and the Far East.


### HARMLESS TO HUMANS

DDT has virtually no adverse effects on humans; and

For more than fifty years DDT has been used, studied, analyzed, and debated--there has been no evidence of DDT's causing harm to humans.

### THE FUZZY SCIENCE BEHIND THE DDT BAN



### **Modifications to Corn:**

Resistant to insect pests;

- Reduce the need for pesticide use;
  - Increase crop yields; and
- Reduce impact on arable land.

  - diarrhea.






### When radicals Win

 lack of mass support for their position.






### **ENVIRONMENTALIST INTERFERENCE**

 unnecessary worldwide product bans.


### **EMPIRICAL OUTCOMES**
